London School of Economics

LSE is one of England's top universities, and with its motto to "understand the causes of things" it only makes sense that the London School of Economics would be one of the first UK educational institutions to teach a course on "Cryptocurrency Investment And Disruption".

Princeton University

Singapore Management University
